

Silver Cross Memorial *June 14/51* Tag Sale Saturday To Raise Remembrance Book Funds

The Silver Cross Women of Canada, Halifax County Branch, will ask YOU Saturday to help provide for a Book of Remembrance to be put in a place of honor in the Halifax Memorial Library.



These women are holding a tag day so that the book containing the names of those to whom the library is dedicated may be made. In this book will be placed the names of every man and woman from Halifax County who gave his or her life in World War Two or in the Korean War.

The task is being carried out by the Silver Cross Women — so-called because they have received from the government of Canada the Silver Memorial Cross presented to mothers and wives of those who died overseas.

The work of designing and illuminating the Book of Remembrance to be presented to the city, has been entrusted to H. P. Bernasconi of Halifax, whose excellent talent is known throughout Canada. This action was decided at the last meeting of the Halifax County Chapter of the Silver Cross, held this week.

The tag day is to be held throughout Dartmouth as well as Halifax.
