

What City Council Did Last Night

Highlights of City Council session last night follow:

1—Approval of erection of a memorial public library on Grafton Park site at a cost not to exceed \$375,000.

2. — Defeat by a 6-4 vote of Alderman John Walker's notice of motion that the control of the Halifax Forum be returned to City Council.

3—A demand by Alderman Walker that three members of the Forum Commission, Deputy Mayor J. E. Lloyd, Aldermen Harry Breen and Frank Adams, resign their posts.

4—Approval of expropriation proceedings against the Murray property at the head of the North West Arm in preparation of plans to beautify entrance to the city. Approval will also be sought for \$15,000 capital borrowings for this purpose.

5 — Deferment until November of a recommendation by the Safety Committee to abandon the Mounted Squad of the Halifax Police Force the end of this year.
